The Open Regional Fund- Legal Reform, GIZ (The Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit) and UN Women/Albania have the pleasure to announce a “Gender equality in the private sector Competition“, as a support for the research project of The German Association of Female Lawyers (Deutscher Juristinnenbund, DJB) that is conducting a study on gender equality and increase of female participation within top managing positions in Germany and on a world wide level. The competition also tends to raise awareness and advocacy on the issue and establish a dialogue between the different actors in the field of gender equality.

Eligibility, conditions and prize

The “Gender equality in the private sector“ Competition aims to provide the opportunity to all undergraduate, postgraduate students and assistant professors (at Faculties of Law, Economy, Political Sciences, Graphic Design and Arts) to express how they perceive, experience and suggest gender equality in private the sector could be reached and enhanced.

The proposals should be submitted in one the following forms:

- academic text 5-10 pages;
- visual art composition (painting, graphic design, photography and sculpture).

The criteria used by the jury to evaluate the submitted proposals will be:

- respecting the theme;
- creativity and originality;
- the relevance of the appropriateness and clarity of message;
- the academic and artistic expression.

The winner will receive a prize consisting of online-publication and a possibility of personal presentation of the text/or art piece.

The deadline for submitting proposals participating in the competition is May 1st 2012 and the competition results will be announced beginning of July 2012.
