Language of Instruction	Programs at EASD Castelló are taught in Spanish. Exchange applicants should demonstrate an intermediate level of Spanish language ability equivalent to B1 on the Common European Framework of References for Languages (CEF). EASD Castelló offers a Spanish language course for exchange students. Throughout this course there is a focus on speaking and writing fluently and with confidence in Spanish, and support will be provided for general communication.
